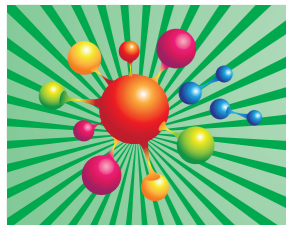

WinkBall gives students access to a number of versatile video publishing tools, enabling them to create their own video education resources, that can be shared online with their classmates and families.





Creating and sharing knowledge

WinkBall enables users to create their own learning resources, which can be shared in collaborative projects or used for their personal records and revision.

Video Blog



A great way of creating a diary of activities and experiences that can be shared with other students, teachers, and parents. For example, if a class goes on a school trip abroad, or is investigating a particular area of study over a number of weeks, a video blog is perfect way to document this online.

Video Wall



A very effective way for a group of learners to share video content with each other, and if required the general public. For example, if a media or history class were using video to collect oral histories of their local area, then a video wall would be a good way to publish their video interviews. The video wall could then be made accessible to the rest of the community and therefore become a valuable resource for others interested in local history.

Video Messaging



Can keep students in contact with other students all over the world, and is a great way to enhance language learning. Video messaging and video chats are also particularly useful for professional mentoring programmes. These video chats can be recorded for future viewing.

Creative video based learning

Using WinkBall is a great way to stimulate critical engagement with a subject.



Teachers can:

- Create and record video tutorials demonstrating step-by-step processes and instructions using a video camera or webcam, and broadcast these as video messages.
- Test language learning via video emails or recordable video chat.
- Exchange regular video emails with students regarding their areas of study.
- Create video messages for a website or VLE
- Keep in regular face to face contact with parents via video messaging.



Students can:

- Record and share class trips to museums, art galleries or outdoor field trips, by uploading videos to student video blogs and video walls.
- Work in collaboration by creating and exchanging video content related to an area of study.
- Use the video chat record facility to interview people online, and communicate with students in other schools.
- Create regular news reports about events and issues important to them.
- Record drama, music and performances, and share them with friends and family.

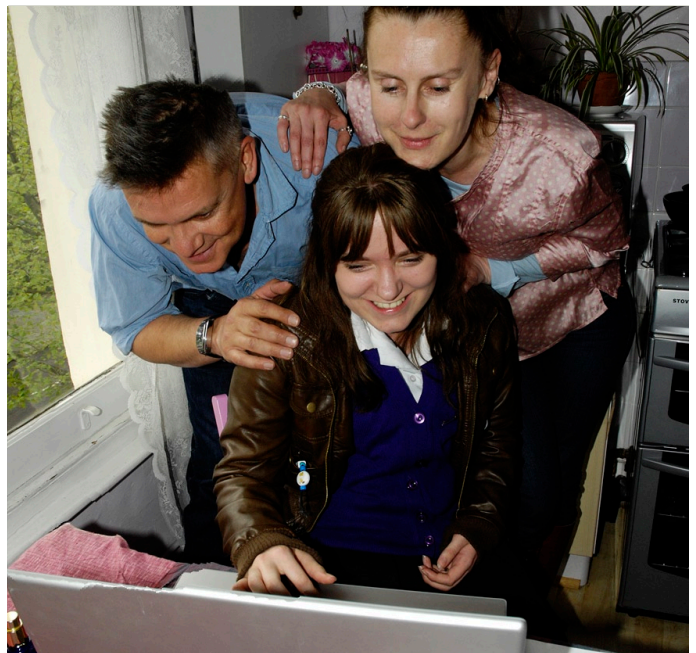
